Waterside Park

The Royal Docks are to become Britain's 'biggest enterprise zone', transforming the area into a brand new district in which to work, live and invest.

The Royal Docks and Greenwich Peninsula are home to ExCeL, the O2 and are a focus for significant regeneration. The 125-hectare enterprise zone is one of London's most exciting development opportunities in the world.

It has recently been revealed that there has been positive interest from investors and major UK developers as well as from further afield for a section of Newham's Royal Docks zone.

Siemens Pavilion

Siemens are investing £30 million in a new landmark building, comprising an exhibition and conference centre, and creating 6,000 new jobs.

This new visitor attraction will be a permanent showcase for sustainable technologies and will host exhibitions and is expected to be completed in early 2012.

Crossrail

By 2013, Custom House DLR station will have a new Crossrail station, and in 2018 this will link through to Paddington, Tottenham Court Road and Heathrow Airport in the west, and Canary Wharf, Liverpool Street and Stratford in the east.

Westfield, Stratford

Opening September 2011, Westfield Stratford will offer shops, restaurants, cafés, cinema, bowling and is under 12 minutes* away by DLR/tube.



Cable Car

The first urban cable car in the UK is under construction, with direct access between Greenwich Peninsula and the Royal Docks and a direct link between the O2 and ExCeL centre. Creating a new visitor attraction for east London, the cars will carry up to 2,500 people an hour across the river and will be complete by summer 2012.

Cruise Liner Terminal

London is set to get its first cruise liner terminal in time for the 2012 Games. Enderby Wharf will provide a docking station for cruise liners and a new station for the Thames Clipper – a ferry service which runs east to west through the City of London.

Canning Town And Custom House Regeneration

Newham Council has identified £3.9 billion to spearhead regeneration for Canning Town and Custom House; revitalising the town centre, providing a new school and additional community facilities.

Leamouth Peninsula

Located opposite the O2, The River City at Leamouth will include an arts centre and gallery, shops, restaurants, cafes and office space.

SS Robin

The world's last remaining steamcoaster is currently mooring outside Millennium Mills for a year while final conservation work is completed. This historic ship is the only ship in the world to be displayed on a floating pontoon.
